## Gallant Lady

is a wonderful classic 65 foot wooden vessel from 1940. Her hull is close grained fir, her upper structure teak, and her interior mahogany. As a Coast Guard certified vessel she is inspected every year for your safety.

She boasts five double cabins, two heads, a ship's library stocked with books of fiction, area wildlife, history, and geology, a roomy wheelhouse so you can take a turn at the wheel, and level spacious decks to enjoy the clean salt air.

Bring your favorite musical instrument, book, sketchpad, or watercolors, and expect to relax against the dynamic backdrops of the Olympic Range and Cascade Mountains.

## History

Built in Tacoma, Washington by the Riggs brothers. Designed for what she has been doing for over 60 years – small group accommodations for camping on the water.

Gallant Lady has had four owners, and has the unique distinction of being one of the oldest vessels in continuous service on Northwest waters. In her early days she made trips to southeastern Alaska and presently serving Puget Sound, San Juan's and Inland Passage of Vancouver Island.

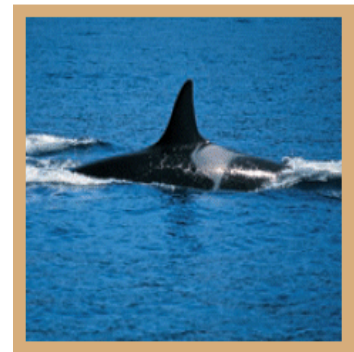
Unwind while exploring by dinghy or beachcombing a secluded shoreline or enjoying the amenities of an island resort.

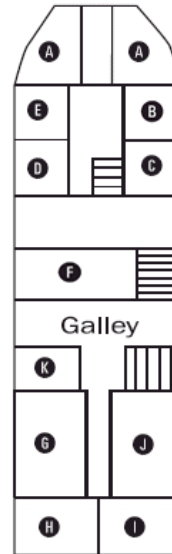

## You Need to Bring:

Adequate food for your group and a crew of three (the group furnishes meals for crew whether on board or ashore).

- Swimming suits (for hot tubs, pools, saunas)
- Soft-soled deck shoes a MUST
- Light rain gear and layers

- Toilets and sinks are on board with showers dockside.
- Hair care appliances may be used at shower facilities on shore - but not on the boat please!

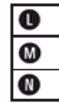


The diagram shows the bunks available, but the proportion of marrieds and singles, male and female will affect the availability of certain bunks.

We recommend a group size of (\*) 24 or less and ask that first time groups limit their size to 20 to become familiar with the facilities.

Many people like to sleep on deck and we have cushioned pads for this.
